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
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

## KYIV - the perks, the life, the standards and the possibilities

Kyiv, the crown jewel located in the heart of Europe, exudes a majestic aura that strikes visitor and dwellers alike with wonder and awe. Built in the early 882 AD, this monolithic city is counted among one of the oldest in the world and had been home to some of the best known primeval human civilizations. The architecture is a seamless blend between the modern and the medieval opulence.

Predominantly a Christian state this grandiose city hosts almost 3 million people and boasts of one of the best public transport systems in the world.

The city is well connected by underground subway system which is branched into 3 separate lines, which grant its citizens access to almost all stretches of the city without having to resort to surface transportation which is supposedly one of the busiest in the world.

Kiev extends her arms to all irrespective of social class, creed, sect or nationalities. In accordance to the recent consensus there are residents and ethnic groups from 130 nations all over the world currently residing in Kiev and finding a place of refuge. The living standards are reasonable compared to the rest of Europe given Ukraine's high currency value and well placed government subsidies.

Modern Kiev is a collage between the old and the new. The ancient heritage of the Kiev-Russ regality is only accentuated by the neo-modern iconic architectures and state of the art technological advances. Most of the heritage building have been preserved to its former glory and has been acclaimed by UNESCO as part of the World Heritage Site.

The city itself is dotted with hyper malls, megamalis and shopping complexes to cater to every need of the people living here and more.

## **WOW FACTS**

- Doctor of medicine O.P. Walter, professor, one of founders and heads at department of anatomy OF NMU (1844-1868) was the first who proved the influence of sympathetic nerves on the blood vessels' fone.
- Professor V.O. Betz, head at department of anatomy (1868–1890), pupil of O.P. Walter, first described the giant cells of brain cortex (world-known as Betz cells), his unique collection of brain specimens (8,000 units) was honored in Vienna at World exhibition at 1873.





## INTERNATIONAL CO-OPERATION

NMU widely conducts activities like student exchange programs, internships, seminars and international projects in partnership with educational institutions abroad which includes the European Regional Office of WHO, The European Association of Public Health. The Federation of Healthcare Facilities in France. The Agency of International Development (USA). The German Agency DAAD. Inter-university center for science and co-operation Eastern and South-Eastern Europe (Italy), which includes 33 universities from 14 countries and from Eastern European network of universities, which form 35 universities. NMU also implemented various international programs in partnership with 101 foreign medical and educational institutions, organizations, associations, including 79 foreign educational institutions.



















NMU is the only university in Ukraine which has a registered memebership with the Consortium of Universities for Global Health CUGH, which builds interdisciplinary collaborations and assists members in sharing their expertise accross education, research and service. NMU co-founded CIRCEOS programs and has partnership in conducting 43 international programs like ERASMUS MUNDUS, TEMPUS and MUMEENA. Over the last three years NMU has participated in the implementation of grant 114 research projects worth about 20 million USD and carried out international scientific and educational projects in the field of medicine and pharmacy. Research grants were carried out in co-operation with 14 countries including Austria, Britain, Denmark, Netherlands, Russia, USA, France, Switzerland and Sweden.















## UNDERGRADUATE MEDICAL FACULTY

The medical faculty at NMU boasts of one of the most sought after course in the country and in the continent of Europe. The medical school is equipped with state-of the art teaching devices in each of the 10 lecture auditoriums within the university premises and world-class laboratories providing students with the necessary technological and clinical know how. The medical school is a conglomerate of 12 faculties, presiding over 7 institutions and 137 super specialty medical centers spread all over Kiev, 78 departments and 30 sub divisional departments.

The school employs 1,200 scientists and teachers; among them 137 are professors, 188 associate professors, 341 assistant professors and 719 lecturers. Apart from them, over 200 academicians and corresponding members of higher education board of Ukraine, laureates of State Prize of Ukraine, honorary Readers and professor emeritus adom the academic positions of this university. The student body of the medical school alone is 13,000 students strong, consisting of both native Ukrainian students and foreign students hailed from all the corners of the world.

The degree awarded to medical students at the end of their 6 years of training is M.D. (Doctor of Medicine, in accordance to WHO and Avicenna Directory) and it makes them eligible to practice in any country in the world after appearing and successfully passing their respective medical licensing examinations.

The university is proud to reveal that every one of four countries in the world has medical graduates from this institution of excellence as a flourishing medical practitioner. This has been made possible by the sheer superior quality of education imparted at this institution and rigorous training courses to season the students with the grueling world of clinical practice.

Students are encouraged and motivated to think independently and creatively. The education is not only textbook oriented as taught in the practical classes and in the auditoriums, but also real-life, clinically oriented problem based learning.


## STUDENT LIFE AT NMU, KYIV

# ADMISSION

## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

- A minimum of 75% score in English at class 10 and 10+2 level (equivalent scores of SAT 1 & 2, O Levels, A Levels, TOEFL or IELTS) is necessary.
- A minimum of 75% score in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together (PCB Criteria) is necessary.
- 3. The following documents should be mailed to the admission liaison at the admission department of O.O. Bogomolets National Medical University at the time of application if the previous criteria have been met:
  - Scanned copy of passport
  - Scanned copy of birth certificate (original)
  - Scanned copy of class 10 (or equivalent
  - Scanned copy of class 12 (or equivalent

Scanned copy of school leaving certificate, character certificate, migration certificate, police verification certificate in original and medical health certification of fitness. [The necessity of the documents stated in clause e, may vary from person to person, and should be consulted with the admission department prior to sending).

The acceptance of the documents from the applicant does not guarantee an admission in O.O. Bogomolets National Medical University, and it should be noted that the documents shall be revised and checked by the admission committee for consideration. If the basic criteria are met, the candidate may be considered for an interview. The decision of the admission committee shall remain final and binding regarding every matter during the admission process.



## VISA

Non-EU and international students need visa to enter Ukraine and live here for prolonged periods of time. The visa type required for students is "D". The documents required to apply for it are;

- 1. The original of student's invitation, confirmed by the Embassy of Ukraine in the country of residence.
- 2. Passport with a valid expiration date that exceeds the term of visa at least by a month
- 3. Official translation of the birth certificate legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country of residence and the Embassy of Ukraine in the country of residence.
- 4. Official translation of the document of secondary and higher education, legalized by the Ministry of foreign Affairs of the country of residence and the Embassy of Ukraine in the country of residence.
- 5. Medical certificate of absence of viral hepatitis or HIV infection (certificate not older than 2 months).
- 6. Official translation of the certificate of health, legalized by the Minisitry of Foreign Affairs of the country of residence and the Embassy of Ukraine in the country of residence (certificate valid for 2 months).
- 7. Copy of open air ticket or return ticket valid for one year with seal from the travel agency.
- 8. Photocopies of the above mentioned documents.
- A completed application form with two passport sized photographs.

Note: The documents and statements of marks from secondary and higher secondary boards are accepted for consideration only after confirmation by the Embassy of Ukraine in the country of residence.
